Vinification : gentle extraction, trapping and long maceration in small stainless steel vats

Ageing : in barrels of french oak renewed by third for 14 Months

Blending : 50% Cabernet Franc, 45% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Petit verdot

Alcohol by volume : 12.5 °
